The town is pleased to announce the commencement of the Shore Road Pathway Project. Bids were opened on May 24th for the construction of the 2.2 mile path. It will extend between the former entrance to Fort Williams Park and the town center adjacent to Key Bank.

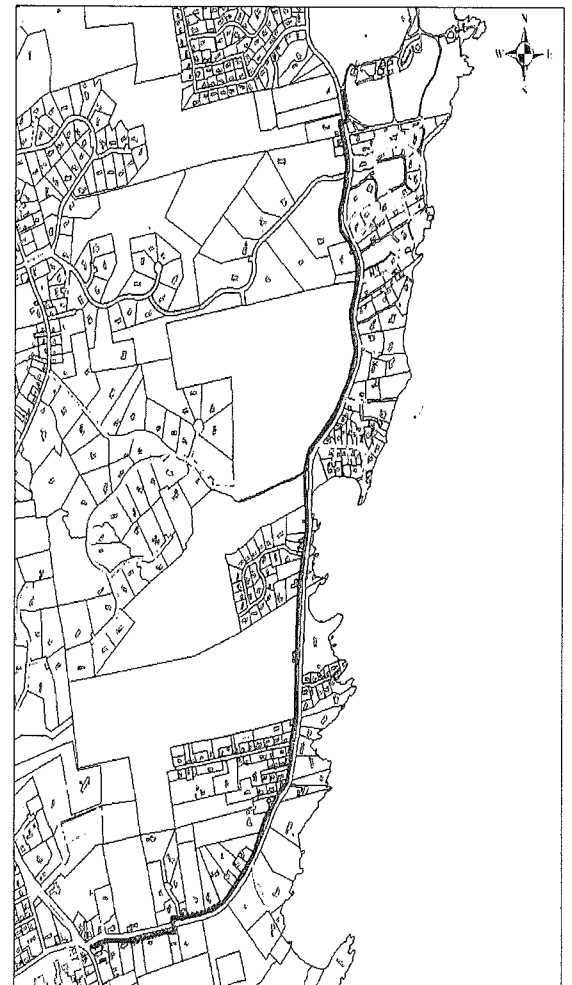
L.P. Murray & Son's, Inc. of Cape Elizabeth submitted the low bid, out of a field of 9 contractors. The firm's office is along the pathway and they have successfully completed a number of Cape Elizabeth municipal projects over many years.

Work will commence during the week of **June 18th**. During several phases of the project, traffic will be slightly delayed, or reduced to one lane. Please be patient as this is common during these types of projects. The work should be completed in approximately 90 to 120 days.
