Attendees introduced themselves and their backgrounds. Paul McKenney stopped by to welcome us to the committee and thank us for participating. Steve is participating as a resource for the committee.

Ernie provided information about what has been happening so far in this area (last 5 +/- years). For example, town is annually using 200,000 gallons of #2 oil, 18,000 gallons of propane. Ernie has overseen the implementation of energy management systems in many of the municipal buildings and he shared the savings that have been achieved so far. CE has about 27 buildings at this time. We are already using about 5% biofuels in our fleet vehicles [? Check this]. None of the CE town buildings have solar panels at this time.

Discussed committee mission and what some other "low hanging fruit" might be and whether the group should have an ultimate goal of "carbon free."

General discussion of energy conservation, electricity generation and a high school energy audit. Discussion of groups such as Clean Air, Cool Planet (http://www.cleanair-coolplanet.org/for_communities/index.php).

There is a possibility of getting graduate student interns involved (progress already being made on this since first meeting).
