- 1. The September 14, 2010 Open Space Management Plan Committee meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chair Dena DeSena.
- 2. The minutes of the July 13, 2010 and August 10, 2010 meeting were read and accepted, following a motion made by Mike Duddy, seconded by Dick Bauman.
- 3. Fire Chief Peter Gleeson spoke and explained the regulations involving camp fires.
 - a. A permit is needed from the Fire Department. They are issued at the Police Station from 8:30 -4:00 p.m. Explanations are listed on the permits. There is no charge if picked up at the Public Safety Office. There is an online charge of \$5. Without a permit, the Fire Department will show up and there will be an \$18 charge. You need to be 18 years to age to get a permit and should have hand tools and a water supply to put out the fire.
 - b. Cooking in a pit is acceptable, but any open fire, even a campfire, requires a permit.
 - c. There is to be no burning whatsoever in the Oakhurst area.
- 4. A review of the Management Plan was done and changes were made accordingly.
- 5. Greenbelt Maintenance Plan Draft Outline was also done and changes also made. A new category was added Titled New Work:
 - 1. New Bridges
 - 2. New Trails
 - 3. New signage
- 6. We critiqued the Maine Plan Activity Table.
- 7. Agreement was to submit our outline to the Town Council.
