The Request for Information will be received by the requested deadline.

Request for Information received after the above stated day and time will not be considered.

The Spurwink School Committee intends to begin review of the submissions on July 14, 2016. At the time of the RFI, each submitter will be presumed to have inspected the site and have made themselves familiar with the facility.

Proposal

The Spurwink School Committee is requesting information as to the intended future use of the Spurwink School based on submitted criteria provided below.

- I. Description of the program or use of the facility
- II. Do you plan on using the entire facility or portion thereof and would you share the facility
- III. Public benefit of the program or use of the facility
- IV. Hours of operation of the program or use of the facility
- V. Resources requested by the program or use of the facility from the Town of Cape Elizabeth (equipment, financial, staffing, etc.)
- VI. Resources provided by the program or use of the facility to meet the needs of the facility for their program or use (specialized equipment, financial, volunteers, staffing etc.)
- VII. Special security, environmental requirements, access requirements or other requests
- VIII. What is your extent of financial ability to cover the costs of facility's utilities
- IX. Timeline for the program or use to be operational (estimated)
- X. Projected capacity levels of the program or use (staffing, volunteers, users, etc.)
- XI. Any other information regarding the program or use pertinent for the Spurwink School Committee review process

The submission shall include the name of the respondent, their position within the requester's organization, and the contact information.
