Consultant Selection discussion:

- Each member presented their assessment of the three consultant groups that we had interviewed: Providence Architecture, Himmel & Wilson, and J. Stewart Roberts. Tangible and intangible factors were cited.
- The recurring themes: (not in order of importance)
 - Quality of their presentation Relevance of experience Leadership quality Ability to listen and respond appropriately General qualities and strengths of entire team Ratio of library consulting time vs. architectural time Cost
- o The preferences expressed by the members, resulted in the following:

Himmel & Wilson	6 (incl. Jay)
J. Stewart Roberts	2

- Note: Though not in attendance, Nancy O'Sullivan sent her appraisal and recommendation to the chair via email prior to the meeting.
- A fourth alternative was considered: Reject all bids and creating a hybrid team made up of a library consultants and an architect from 2 different groups that we interviewed. The question arose "Is it legal and ethical for us to consider such an arrangement?" Jay was asked to discuss this with the Town Manager.
- The groups interviewed have worked together on other projects. How well did they work together? Was the client satisfied? Anne will check references and report to the committee.
- Nancy Marshall will contact Bill Wilson (Himmel & Wilson) to determine the need of 2 architectural firms on the team, and the cost implications if one could be eliminated without loss of quality.

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Consultant Selection discussion: (continued)

- Ed will contact Himmel & Wilson to obtain a breakdown of hours by team member and phase in order to complete a meaningful comparison to the other 2 consultant teams.
- As a result of the aforementioned issues, it was determined that further discussion was warranted and we would resume deliberations at the May 15th meeting.
