- f) **Superintendent's Report -** Following some faculty communications around climate, the Superintendent and principals have discussed bringing in a consultant to do some work to identify concerns and how to best move forward. A change to the **2015-2016 academic year calendar** will need to be made, necessitated by a PATHS sending school with a contractual obligation to begin after the Labor Day holiday. Our start date would need to be adjusted by four school days to a September 8 start with a last day of school on June 24 if five storms days are used. A revised college placement counselor job description was shared and discussed. Pond Cove has been identified as a monitor school this year under the NCLB Act. Cape Celebrates Literacy kicks off April 6-10.
