#### 5. COMMUNICATIONS -

- a) **Pond Cove Principal of the Day Declan Scifres** spoke briefly about his experience serving as principal of Pond Cove.
- b) Recognitions -

**Annemieke Buterbaugh** read her winning essay describing her mural installation at Pond Cove Elementary School. Annemieke won a full summer camp scholarship to the Maine College of Art.

Legislative sentiments from Senator Rebecca Millett were presented to **Lily Jordan** and **Will Steidl** in recognition of their National Scholastic Art and Writing Awards.

c) Annual Report of Volunteer Services - Director of Volunteer Services, Gail Schmader, provided a brief overview of volunteer efforts as provided within Cape Elizabeth Schools' volunteer services annual report. *More detailed information from Gail's report can be found online.* 

- d) Recognition of **Retirees** Retiring staff **Gail Schmader** (25 yrs), **Belinda Snell** (28 yrs), **Jamie Michaud** (21 yrs), **Karen Abbott** (17 yrs) and **Tracy Greenwood** (28 yrs) were individually recognized. A brief reception immediately followed.
- e) **Administrators' Strategic Plan updates** Principals Tracy, Hasson and Shedd, and Director of Instruction Ruth Ellen Vaughn briefly updated the Board on strategic plan related endeavors within the buildings and the district.
- f) National Center for School Leadership 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual (parent/student) Survey Results Superintendent Nadeau presented a brief <u>overview</u> of the approximately 800<sup>+</sup> pages of data from the district's 2<sup>nd</sup> annual student and parent engagement and satisfaction surveys. It is expected that the staff climate and culture survey will be completed by the end of school.

Surveys were administered by the National Center for School Leadership (NCSL) between mid-to late January 2015 with results returned to the district in late March. The district leadership team reviewed those results in April and May. Surveying was conducted to help in identifying progress made around the district's mission/vision/values and to collect stakeholder input.

The NCSL considers constituent responses at least 10% above the national average as 'very positive', within a 20% or more unfavorable rating as 'presenting opportunities', and responses within 10% or more below the national average as areas to 'shed more light on'.

g) **Superintendent's Report** - Superintendent Nadeau updated the board on items of interest happening within the district during the past month. Cape Elizabeth Schools' has entered into an agreement to share costs and resources of its Director of School Nutrition with the Scarborough Schools. Enrollment: current incoming 5th grade at 112 students (at projection), 4th grade at 140 (a bit above), kindergarten is at 92 students. Anticipate one-year elementary teacher job postings for grades K and four at this point. Search for a special education director continues.
